Dear People of God,

Do you hear what I hear?
Angels we have heard on high...
Hark! The herald angels sing...
Listen:

"I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people" (Luke 2:10, NRSV)

Christmas time is an invitation to listen, which is so much more than hearing. To listen is to pay attention and to be attentive.

Mary heard and was attentive to the message of the angel, and acted with a resounding yes: "let it be with me according to your word." (Luke 1:38, NRSV)
