Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As we celebrate the Jubilee Year 2025, Pope Francis reminds us that "hope should be granted to the billions of the poor who often lack the essentials of life" and that "the goods of the Earth are not destined for a privileged few but for everyone." (Spes Non Confundit, 15-16). This is a time for renewal, reflection, and action, and we are called to bring hope and fairness to the world.

Inspired by this call, Development and Peace – Caritas Canada (DPCC), the official development organization of the Catholic Church in Canada, invites each of us to join Caritas Internationalis' global Share Lent campaign, Turn Debt into Hope.

Caritas Internationalis is one of the world's largest humanitarian organizations, and DPCC is a proud member. Together, they are calling for fair treatment for communities burdened by debt they cannot repay.

In the Bible, a Jubilee year included three key actions: freeing slaves, letting the land rest, and canceling debts. Today, we are encouraged to take similar steps to restore hope. Many countries in the Global South struggle with overwhelming debt, which makes life harder for their people. Pope Francis' message for this Jubilee Year shares that "if we really wish to prepare a path to peace in our world, we must commit ourselves to remedying the remote causes of injustice, settling unjust and unpayable debts." (Spes Non Confundit, 16).

I encourage you to join a worldwide community of Catholics in bringing hope to all people by:
